

Summer Fenn 2022 Covid-19 Policies and Guidelines (Updated 12/29/22)

These policies are subject to update based on current guidance from local and national health officials and Fenn school leadership.

Vaccinations are currently not required to attend Summer Fenn, however... Summer Fenn reserves the right to update this policy without advance notice at any point before or during the summer season. NO REFUNDS for deposit or tuition will be given if your vaccine-eligible child needs to withdraw from camp because a mandate is instated and your child is not vaccinated. IF/WHEN a vaccination mandate was to be instated at Summer Fenn, we will always allow for documented medical and other legal exemptions, and we reserve the right to require a testing protocol for any/all unvaccinated individuals attending camp with such valid exemptions.

Masking is currently optional for both indoor and outdoor activity, although there may be specific circumstances under which we require masking indoors (for example for large, indoor gatherings or if we see an uptick in a certain group/age range, etc)

Hand Hygiene is a regular part of our daily camp routine, as well as numerous hand sanitizer stations throughout the campus.

Outdoor Programming + Enhanced Ventilation will keep optimal air exchange conditions throughout the summer, even if we need to be indoors. Our programs will be outdoors whenever possible, and we fully expect families to provide the necessary clothing and gear to play outdoors in light rain.

Fenn has invested in HVAC upgrades to maximize air exchange rates in indoor spaces where specialty camps and inclement weather activities may take place.

Any campers who test positive, present with symptoms, or are deemed to be close contacts, must follow the state guidance for testing, isolation and return to activity.

By enrolling in and attending Summer Fenn, you agree to perform a daily health screening for yourself (if bringing your child on campus) and your child for whom you are the legal guardian. If the result of that wellness screening shows your child has any symptoms of Covid-19, you agree to keep your child home and contact the camp health office immediately for further instructions.
